As a composer and arranger, Dom has studied with George Fenton (composer: Planet Earth, Mrs Henderson Presents), Jonny Williams (orchestration: 24), Pete Long (Jools Holland Band) and Paul Clark (composer: Cat in Hat, Attempts on her Life, National Theatre). Having had a classical training, his output is across a broad range of musical styles. In addition to commissioned work, he writes for the DeWolfe music library and his music has been heard on numerous primetime shows such as *Come Dine with Me* and *Rab C. Nesbitt*. He has particular experience in sound design and musical treatments for live events. This is reflected by his frequent collaboration with food event supremos and artists Bompas and Parr.
